(non-refundable, lids removed)

dry, lids removed)  
Plastic clam shell packaging (bakery  
& produce)  
Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs & lids  
(i.e. food & beverage containers,  
household cleaning products, laundry  
detergent, shampoo bottles, etc.)  
Pop/juice cans  
Small scrap metal items  
(utensils, pots & pans, baking  
sheets, metal coat hangers)  
Steel cans  
Yogurt/pudding/applesauce cups



**\*\* These items are not recyclable:**  
Flower pots/trays  
Blister packaging  
Chip bags  
Candy wrappers  
**Ashes** - Residents must place Ashes on the curb by 6 a.m. On the dates specified or **they will not be picked up until the next month.** Ensure ASHES are placed in a metal or suitable container and fully extinguished. **DO NOT place Ashes in with the normal waste** and ensure they are a safe distance from combustibles.
